Offer Name: EnergyAustralia 7% Electricity and 7% Gas Discount

Fuel Type: Electricity and Gas

Availability: Residential customers in Ausgrid's electricity network area and the Jemena Coastal gas network area (within the Sydney Metropolitan, Blue Mountains, Hunter and Wollongong areas).

Contract Type(s): Market Agreements for both electricity and gas, 2-year term.

Discount: 7% off the regulated rates for electricity (including the Service Availability Charge(s) and the PureEnergy tariffs) for the duration of your 2-year agreement and 7% off the regulated rates for gas. The discount will appear on the front page of your bills as a credit against the GST exclusive total of the rates on your bills.

PureEnergy: PureEnergy10, 25, 50 and 100 are available.

Electricity Rates: The following rates are the same as the regulated rates and are for customers on a market agreement in Ausgrid's electricity network area. They apply to any supply you receive from us under this agreement up until, and including, 30 June 2012.

Rate Variations:

We may vary the rates (including the Service Availability Charge) under this energy agreement at any time in line with the changes to the regulated rates or as permitted by the Agreement Conditions. Regulated rates generally change in July each year. In the event of no current regulated rates being available, we may vary the rates at any time, generally by giving you 28 days' notice in writing. We will notify you of any changes in writing. This may be in your bill. Your bills will show rates exclusive of GST and GST will be added to the totals.

Effective 1 July each year, we may vary the PureEnergy tariffs. We will publish the variations in a newspaper that is generally circulated in your area and on our website before this date. In addition, we will also notify you of any changes in writing, which may be in a bill.
