Tallawarra A power station has performed reliably since its official opening in March 2009, and has continued to meet its strict noise and emission licence requirements.

It is Australia's most efficient gas-fired power station, generating over 400 megawatts of electricity - enough energy to power more than 200,000 homes.

Maintenance procedures are regularly undertaken on the plant, and as a company that places safety first, we are pleased to report there have been no lost time injuries over the past year of operation.

You may have noticed new lighting along the Yallah Bay Road Lake Illawarra foreshore area.
