This year, we will distribute up to \$45,000 in grant funding across 2 rounds (in July and November) to local organisations who can address key social issues currently facing our region. We accept grant applications for funding of up to \$10,000 per project.

Applications for Round 2 will be accepted between 9am, Wednesday 1st November 2023 and 5pm, Thursday 30th November 2023

All applications will be reviewed against the following criteria:

- **The organisation:** The applicant has a clear purpose, clearly understands who it is targeting and how it addresses the issue.
- **Social Issue:** The issue is important to the local community and addresses one of the outlined priority areas. The applicant should demonstrate that the project is directed at solving problems in a sustainable way rather than providing short-term relief from symptoms or long-term dependency.
- **Funding:** The proposal clearly outlines how donated funds will be utilised. The grant amount should cover a significant part, if not all, of the total project cost. Priority will be given towards projects that are unlikely to be supported through government or private funding programs.
- Measures: There are measures in place to evaluate project success.
