	As well as providing commentary, it helpfully visually represents the changes						
	in traffic flow and the effectiveness of the roads and key intersections in the network under the various scenarios.						
	This allows the reader to see how the potential development of Tallawarra						
	Lands may increase or decrease take-up of various key parts of network						
	traffic infrastructure.						
	The traffic report and underlying modelling have been considered by the						
	relevant government agencies, and been peer reviewed.
